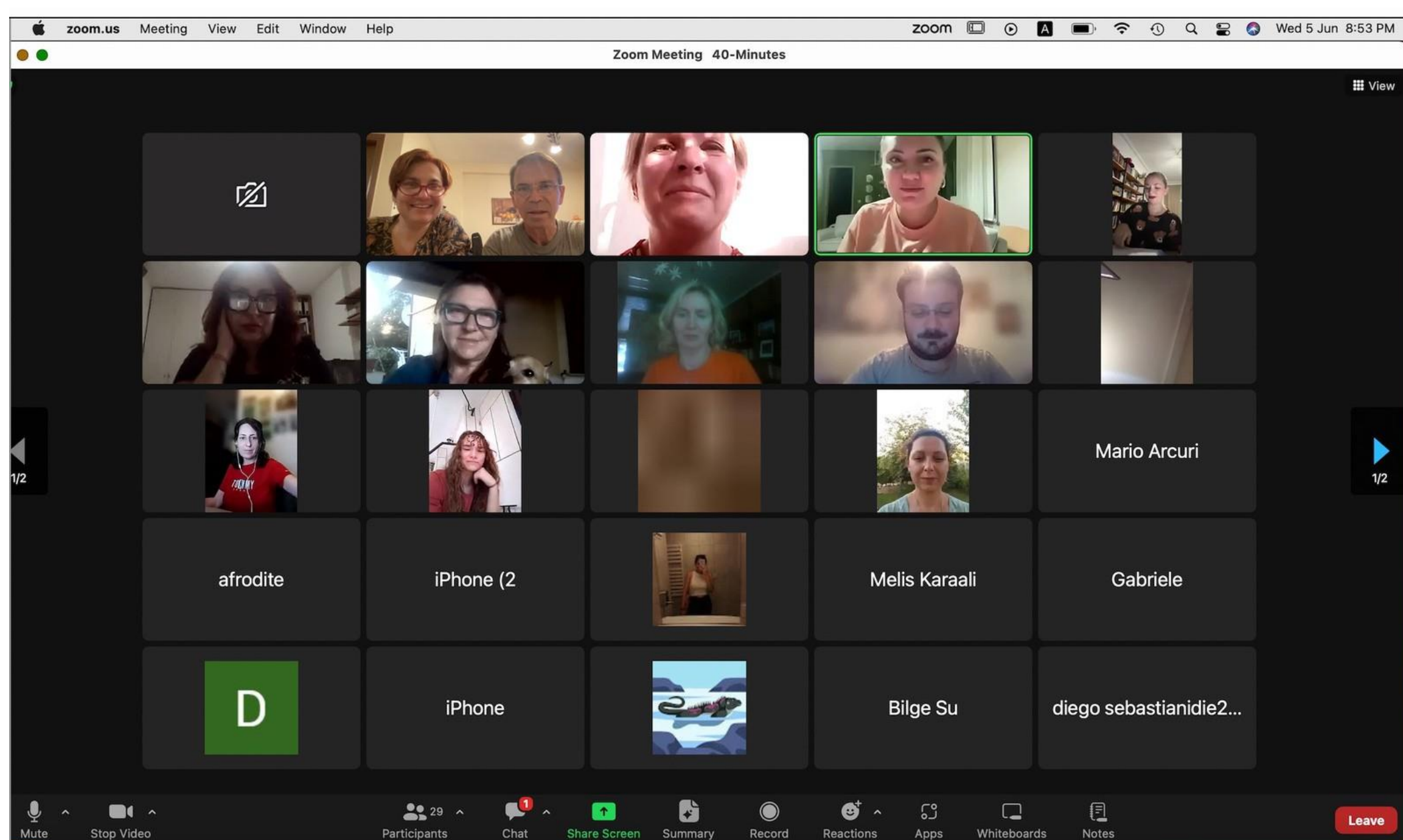


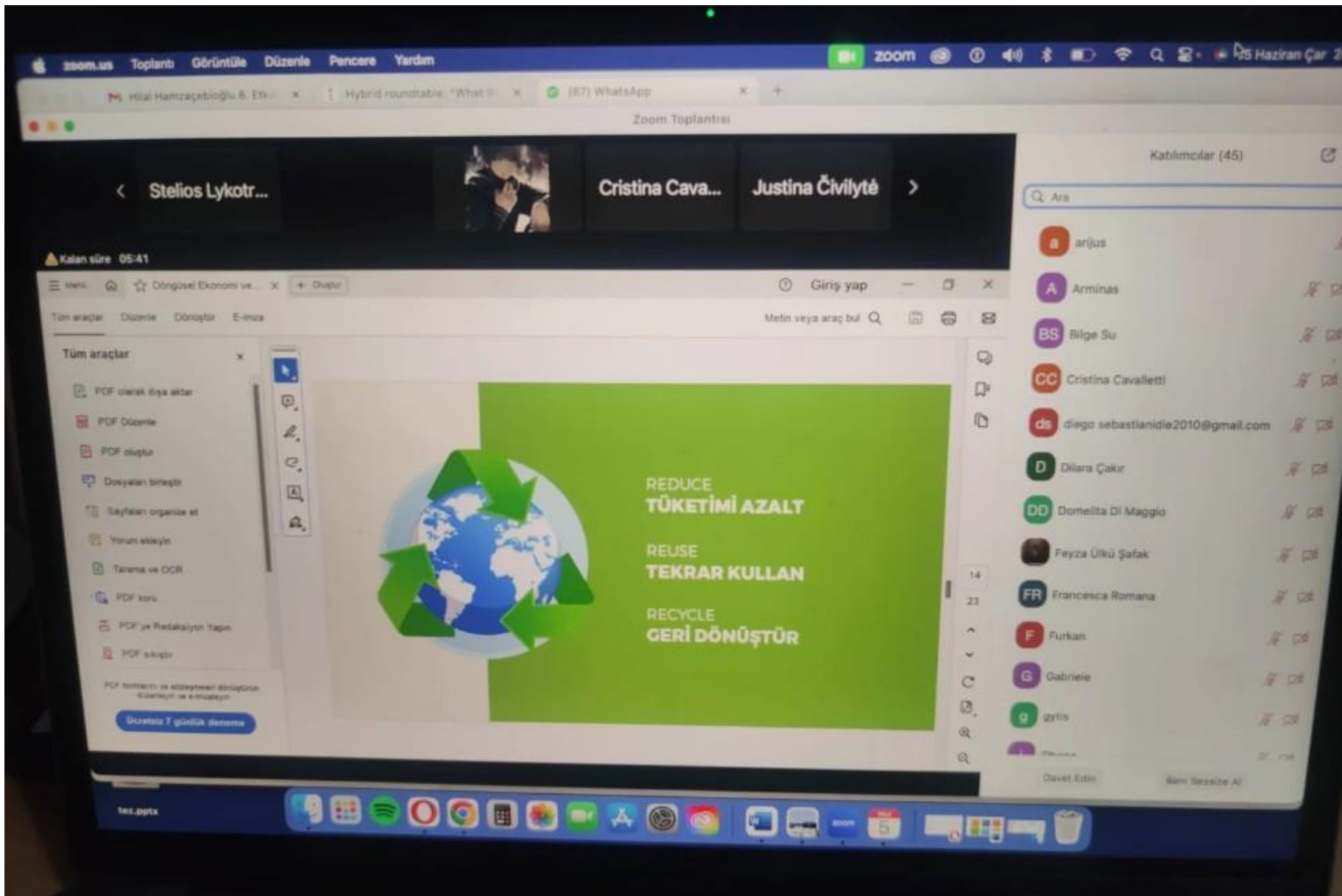
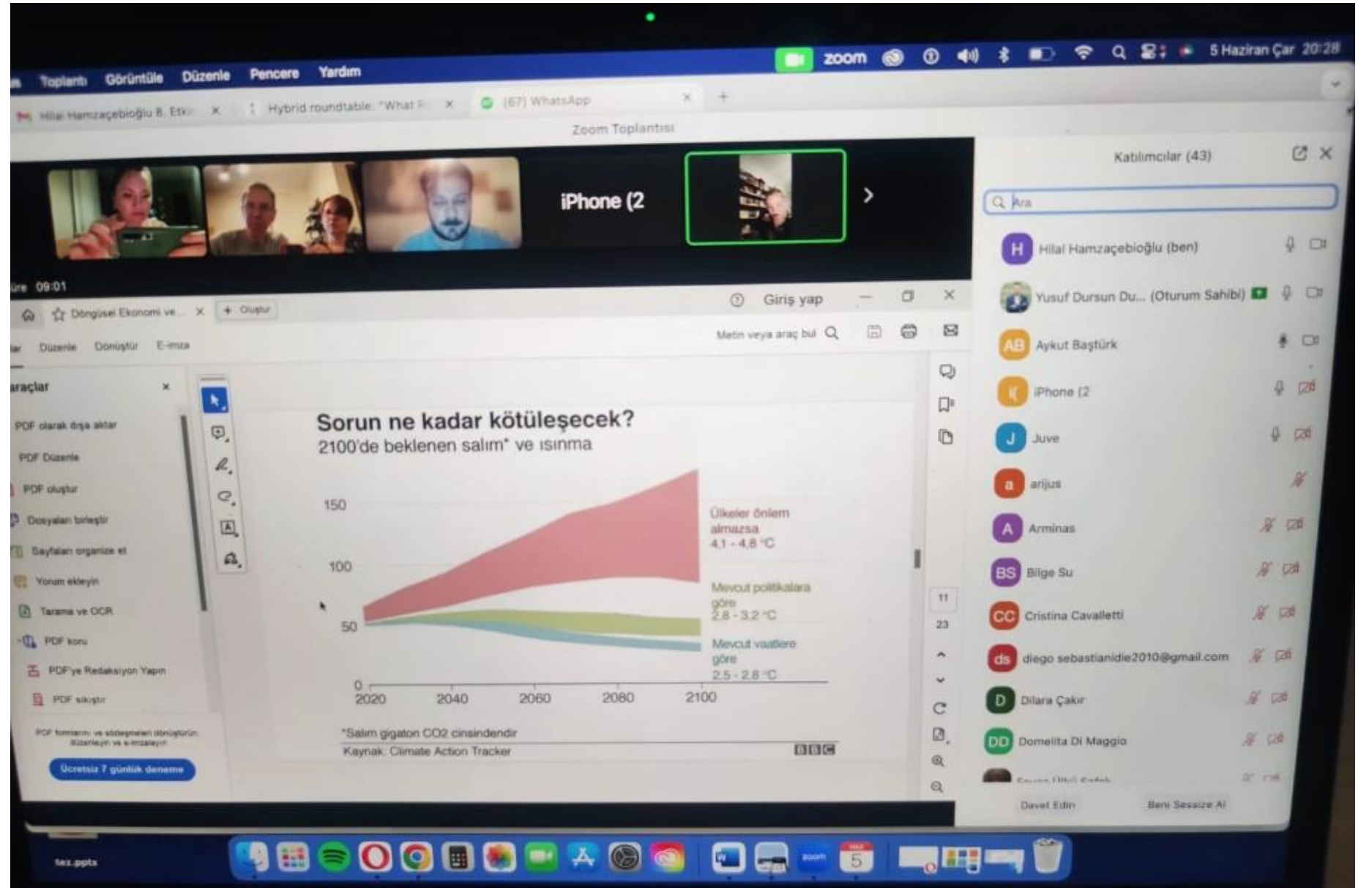
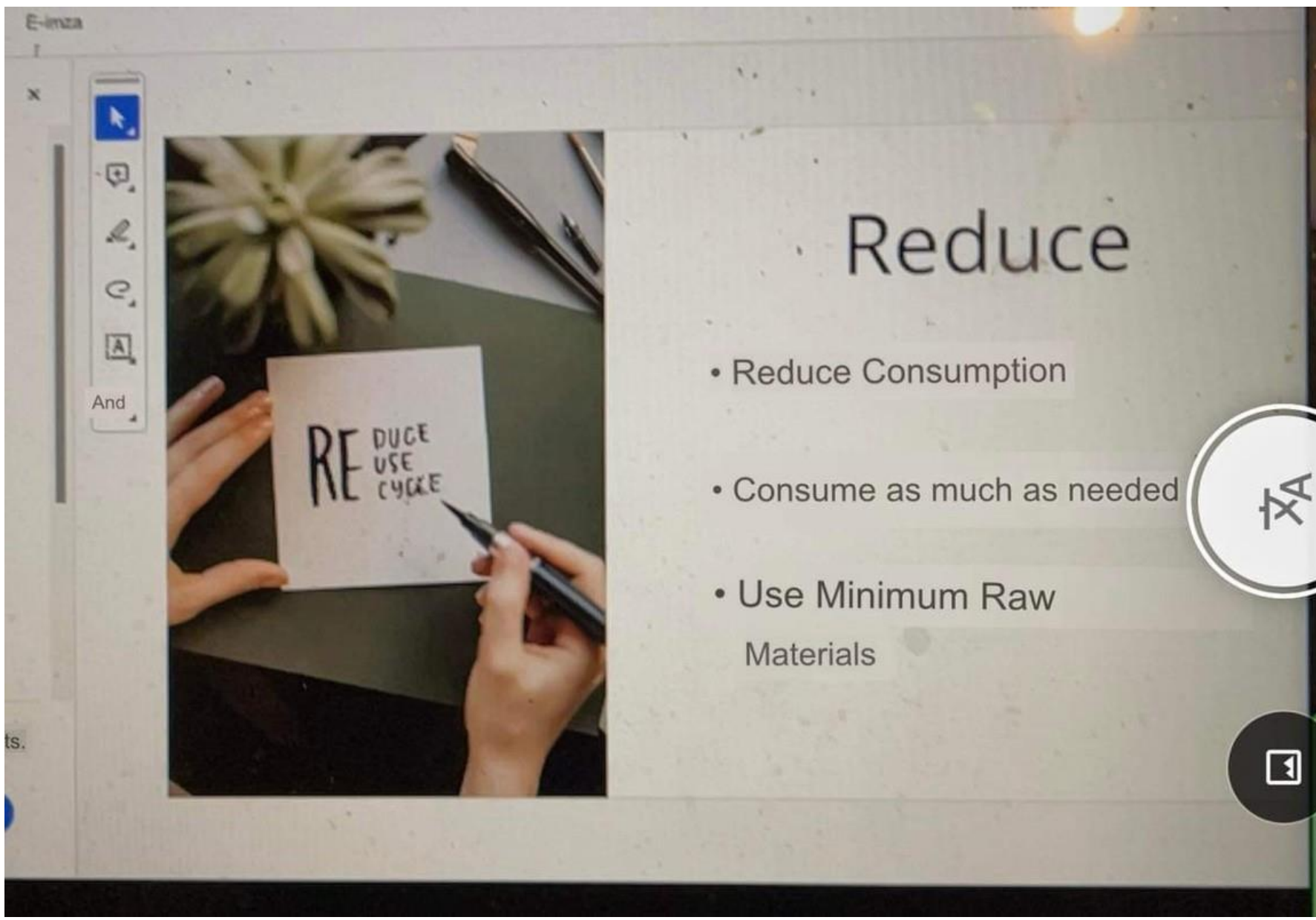
VIRTUAL MOBILITY IN WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY (June, 5 2024)

Description of the Virtual Mobility

The project partners organised a virtual mobility on the occasion of World Environment Day (5 June), a global United Nations initiative promoting environmental action in over 150 countries. The activity included a keynote intervention by the leader of the TEMA Foundation (Türkiye Erozyonla Mücadele, Ağaçlandırma ve Doğal Varlıkları Koruma Vakfı), focusing on the fight against single-use plastics and the transition to a circular economy. Digital tools were used to enable the participation of both students and teachers. Although 8 participants from each partner school were originally planned to enrol in the virtual mobility, it ended up that 63 students and teachers (including disadvantaged learners who could not take part in physical mobilities) were finally actively involved. This is real evidence that the activity succeeded in raising students' environmental awareness and strengthened their understanding of sustainable practices.
